## ADAPTER VERSION

## DIRECT THREAD

### OVERVIEW

---



*The Adapter Version attaches to your shifter assembly using a Likewise adapter.*



*The Direct Thread Version attaches to your shifter assembly without using a Likewise adapter.*

### DESIGN

---



*The Adapter Version has a flared base that is designed to fit a Likewise Adapter. This includes the Disco Biscuits, Euro Adapters, Ford Adapters, and Veloster Adapters.*



*The Direct Thread Version has a straight base which is internally threaded in four thread sizes. This includes M12x1.25mm, M10x1.5mm, M10x1.25mm and M8x1.25mm.*

## COMPATIBILITY

---



*The adapter version must be used where a Likewise adapter is required. This includes vehicles that have a reverse lockout or require the Euro Adapter, Ford Adapter, or Veloster Adapter.*



*The Direct Thread Version can be used if a Likewise adapter is not required. This includes any vehicle that has a simple threaded shifter assembly.*

## SUMMARY

*Please note: in some cases the Adapter Version and Direct Thread Version can be used interchangeably. This is a personal preference.*
